



Hungry Caterpillar by Julie Barclay























 One night a little egg lay on a leaf.

On Tuesday he ate through 2 pears.






On Wednesday he ate through 3 plums.

On Thursday he ate through 4 strawberries.







On Friday he was still hungry.

That night he had a stomach ache.



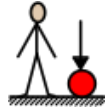

Now the caterpillar was not hungry.

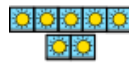
 
He was a big fat caterpillar.
